GREENVILLE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN STEERING COMMITTEE TO MEET

The Town of Greenville Comprehensive Plan Steering Committee will meet to review and make modifications to a framework that will help guide the Town's future development. The framework consists of a future land use map, and a set of goals, strategies and recommendations. Preparation of these documents is the culmination of extensive work done by the Comprehensive Plan Steering Committee, and through a series of public participation opportunities.

The meeting will be held at 5:30 pm on Tuesday, July 15, 2008, at the Greenville Town Hall (W6860 Parkview Drive). The project website provides further information regarding all steering committee meetings, public meetings, draft plan chapters, and the overall comprehensive planning process.

The Town of Greenville has contracted with the East Central Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission (ECWRPC) to serve as the staff to guide the Town's Smart Growth planning process. In addition to Comprehensive and Land Use Planning, other services provided by the Commission include: Transportation Improvement and Corridor Planning; Open Space, Recreational and Environmental Planning; Economic Development; Demographic Information and Projections; Technical Assistance to Local Governments; Geographic Information Services and Aerial Photography Distribution.
